Timothy Noon has been director of music at Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral since 2007. He received his musical education as a chorister in Hereford Cathedral and subsequently as organ scholar at Christ Church, Oxford. Following appointments at St Patrick's Cathedral, Dublin, and Canterbury Cathedral, he became organist and master of the choristers at St Davids Cathedral, Pembrokeshire, where he was also artistic director of the St Davids Cathedral Festival, and principal conductor of the Dyfed Choir. In September 2011 he is moving to New Zealand, to take up the position of director of music at Holy Trinity Cathedral, Auckland.
