Peter Shepherd, aged 16, was a chorister at Worcester Cathedral for seven years until August 2009. He has been the senior organ scholar at Great Malvern Priory since September of the same year. He also plays the piano and the french horn and has started to compose works for the organ as well as for wider-scale instrumentation, hoping to take music on in his life in one shape or another.
